

YOUTH SUMMER CAMP RULES

1. Stay with the group at all times and participate in all camp activities, services, meals, competitions, prayer times, and cabin responsibilities.
2. Respect and follow the direction of your counselors, parent safety, and camp staff at all times.
3. Cell phones may only be used during designated free time.
4. If inappropriate content is accessed, shared, or displayed on a device, it will be confiscated and returned directly to a parent or guardian.
5. Campers may only be in their assigned cabins during designated times. No student may be alone in a cabin ever.
6. No inappropriate physical contact or PDA. Students are not permitted in cabins of the opposite sex.
7. Bullying, harassment, disrespectful behavior, vandalism, or pranks will not be tolerated.
8. Campers are expected to dress appropriately and respect all camp property and facilities.
 - The creek is off limits. If a ball falls down there please ask staff to retrieve it
 - Check out sports equipment and games at the front office
9. Possession of cigarettes, vapes, alcohol, drugs, weapons, or any other prohibited items may result in immediate dismissal from camp at the discretion of the Youth Pastor.
10. All medications must be handled according to camp procedures.
11. Failure to follow camp rules may result in loss of privileges, parent notification, or dismissal from camp.
12. Most importantly, have fun! These guidelines exist to keep everyone safe and help create the best camp experience possible.

TFH YOUTH MODESTY POLICY

1. Please do not wear spaghetti straps, strapless or halter tops, baggy clothing items which expose undergarments, clothing that exposes bare midriffs, and no short shorts/skirts/dresses.
2. Leggings or long spandex shorts should be worn with a long shirt, or a shirt/flannel/sweatshirt should be tied around your waist.
3. Absolutely no cut-off t-shirts of any kind.
4. Boys' shorts should have a minimum of a 7" inseam.
5. Swimwear: All swimwear must be full-coverage. One piece swimsuits are preferred (no cut-outs). If you choose to wear a two-piece swimsuit, you must also wear a t-shirt for the duration of your time around the pool.
6. All students must remain fully clothed, except when wearing bathing suits while in and around the waterfront or pool areas.
7. Camp leadership reserves the right to determine whether clothing is appropriate for camp and may require a student or leader to change clothing that does not align with these guidelines.

Cell Phone Policy

At TFH Youth Camp, our goal is to create a fun, safe, and distraction-free environment where campers can fully engage in meaningful connections, personal growth, and spiritual breakthroughs. While we recognize the role cell phones play in daily life, excessive screen time can take away from the camp experience. To foster a more interactive and immersive atmosphere, we have established the following cell phone policy:

Here are the guidelines for the cell phone policy:

Limited Access to Personal Devices: Campers may use their phones only during designated free time from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM. Outside of these hours, all phones must be turned in to camp counselors during night sessions and will remain with camp staff until the next free time. **Medical exceptions will be accommodated.**

Emergency & Necessary Communication: If a camper needs to make an urgent call outside of free time, they may request to use a camp-provided phone.

Family Responsibility: Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring their camper understands and follows this policy, as well as all TFH Youth Camp rules. Families are strongly encouraged not to send their camper with a phone to help them fully embrace the camp experience.

Policy Enforcement: Any violation of this policy may result in the confiscation of the device and/or additional disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by camp staff
