1 HAVE FUN

Leave space for relationships to form, make this the highlight of someone's week.

2 CREATE ATMOSPHERE

Make a welcoming environment.

3 CULTIVATE CONVERSATIONS ABOUT JESUS

4 WELCOME PEOPLE

Help people connect within your group, facilitate relationships, and have eyes for new people coming in.

5 HIGHLIGHT STUDENTS

6 PARTNER WITH PARENTS

If you WIN the parent, you WIN the student.

7 COME READY

Read, meditate and study the message notes from Rally and the weekend.

LEADERSHIP ROLES

BE PRESENT AND ENGAGED.

- Make sure students are always extending the invitation to their peers
- Show up at 6:25PM for our Leader's Meeting
- Consistently recruit new students for your group
- Be present until ALL your students have left

The time of discussion during Groups creates a safe, welcoming space where people can share and be heard, listen to others and grow together. God's heart is for us to share life with others and commune with one another.

PREPARATION

BE EXPECTANT AT RALLY AND ON WEEKENDS

- Listen to what God is sharing during the message, these are the keys of connecting the message to your life first – then it will flow out to others.

TALK WITH YOUR CO-LEADER

- Share with each other what you got out of the message and what you want to talk about.
- If you miss group, make sure to communicate with your co-lead in advance to have a plan B, so you are never scrambling.

DURING GROUP

GAUGE THE ATMOSPHERE

If you don't set the atmosphere, your student will.

SET A TIME FRAME

Honor the people in the room and have a set time goal of when you want to start and end discussion. We suggest 1 hour to 1 hour and 30 mins of connecting, discussion, and prayer to balance the night.

HAVE A GAME PLAN

Pick a few key scriptures/points from the message to dig deeper into rather than just skimming through the whole message. Have questions ready to build on each other.

BREAK WALLS DOWN

Warm up the room if necessary when you start the discussion with a fun question, opening in prayer, introducing yourself, or sharing the purpose of your group time.

GROUP DISCUSSION

KEYS TO REMEMBER

1 ENGAGE

Ask questions that are open for everyone to answer. Don't spend too much time talking yourself.

2 REDIRECT

As the leader of the group, feel confident to redirect the conversation with another question or thought if it gets too off topic from the heart of the message.

3 BE FLEXIBLE

Let God into the room; pray during the group time and for the people in the room, allowing the Holy Spirit to lead you. If the group time didn't hit an expectation don't feel it is on you. Keep the focus on pointing people to Jesus and building the church.

4 PRAYER

End the night strong in prayer. Having people either break off and pray in groups or as a big group asking for prayer requests and praise reports. Create a culture during the week to be praying for the requests from group and checking in on how they are doing.
